



Group Anti-Bribery and Corruption Policy

Prudential is committed to maintaining the highest standards of integrity and ethical conduct. The Group Anti-Bribery and Corruption (ABC) Policy outlines the principles and framework for managing bribery and corruption risks across the Group's global operations.

The Policy sets out:

- The Group's risk appetite and governance approach to ABC compliance.
- Mandatory requirements for all business units and controlled joint ventures.
- Alignment with international laws including the UK Bribery Act, US Foreign Corrupt Practices Act, and Hong Kong's Prevention of Bribery Ordinance.

The Group prohibits any form of bribery or corrupt behaviour, including offering, giving, requesting, or receiving improper benefits to influence decisions or gain unfair advantage.

The Policy supports early detection, reporting, and mitigation of ABC risks, and promotes a culture of transparency and accountability.

Enhanced roles and responsibilities across the organisation ensure clear ownership of ABC risk management, helping protect the Group's reputation and uphold trust with stakeholders.
