MALAYSIAN RED CRESCENT LAUNCHES ‘SAFE STEPS, SAFE SCHOOL, SAFE KIDS’ (5SK) INITIATIVE TO ADVANCE SCHOOL SAFETY THROUGH CURRICULUM ENHANCEMENT

Kuala Lumpur, 27 May 2025 – The Malaysian Red Crescent (MRC) is pleased to officially announce the launch of its pioneering *Safe Steps, Safe School, Safe Kids* (5SK) initiative , a holistic programme aimed at strengthening school safety and preparedness for children across Malaysia.

In partnership with **Prudence Foundation** and with support from the **International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies (IFRC)**, the 5SK programme will be implemented over a 36-month period from September 2024 to August 2027. The initiative will embed key safety and preparedness elements into the national school curriculum, fostering a culture of resilience through both education and community engagement.

The 5SK initiative builds upon the success of the *SAFE STEPS Kids* (SSK) programme, which reached over **2,140 students across 89 schools** in six states: Sarawak, Sabah, Kelantan, Kuala Lumpur, Johor Bahru and Kedah. The programme equipped schoolchildren with essential life-saving knowledge in areas such as disaster preparedness, first aid, road safety, hygiene promotion, stress management and climate change adaptation.

In recognition of the urgent need to integrate school safety into formal education, MRC will lead efforts to revise the national curriculum in collaboration with key stakeholders, including the Ministry of Education (MOE), UNICEF, IFRC and WWF Malaysia. The revised curriculum will include tailored Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) modules aimed at empowering students, teachers and parents to identify and address local risks through interactive and participatory learning approaches.

To commemorate this milestone, MRC will organise a series of activities including a **webinar, exhibition and hackathon**, highlighting the impact of the programme and promoting strategies to enhance school safety. The initiative is also set to gain international recognition, with participation and knowledge exchange opportunities extended to fellow Red Cross and Red Crescent National Societies.

BULAN SABIT MERAH MALAYSIA LANCAR INISIATIF ‘LANGKAH SELAMAT, SEKOLAH SELAMAT, ANAK SELAMAT’ (5SK) UNTUK MEMPERKASA KESELAMATAN SEKOLAH MELALUI PENAMBAHBAIKAN KURIKULUM

Kuala Lumpur, 27 Mei 2025 – Bulan Sabit Merah Malaysia (BSMM) dengan sukacitanya mengumumkan pelancaran rasmi inisiatif *Langkah Selamat, Sekolah Selamat, Anak Selamat* (5SK), sebuah program menyeluruh yang bertujuan untuk memperkuuh keselamatan dan kesiapsiagaan sekolah dalam kalangan kanak-kanak di seluruh Malaysia.

Dilaksanakan dengan kerjasama **Prudence Foundation** dan disokong oleh **Persekutuan Antarabangsa Persatuan Palang Merah dan Bulan Sabit Merah (IFRC)**, program 5SK akan dilaksanakan selama 36 bulan bermula dari September 2024 hingga Ogos 2027. Inisiatif ini akan mengintegrasikan elemen-elemen keselamatan penting ke dalam kurikulum kebangsaan serta memupuk budaya ketahanan melalui pendidikan dan penglibatan komuniti.

Inisiatif 5SK dibina berdasarkan kejayaan program *SAFE STEPS Kids* (SSK) yang telah melibatkan lebih **2,140 murid dari 89 buah sekolah** di enam negeri: Sarawak, Sabah, Kelantan, Kuala Lumpur, Johor Bahru dan Kedah. Program ini telah berjaya memperlengkapkan murid-murid sekolah dengan ilmu asas menyelamatkan nyawa seperti kesiapsiagaan bencana, pertolongan cemas, keselamatan jalan raya, promosi kebersihan, pengurusan tekanan dan adaptasi perubahan iklim.

Menyedari keperluan mendesak untuk mengintegrasikan keselamatan sekolah dalam sistem pendidikan formal, BSMM akan menerajui usaha menyemak semula kurikulum kebangsaan dengan kerjasama pihak berkepentingan utama seperti Kementerian Pendidikan (KPM), UNICEF, IFRC, dan WWF Malaysia. Kurikulum baharu ini akan merangkumi modul **Pengurangan Risiko Bencana (DRR)** yang direka khas untuk memperkasakan pelajar, guru dan ibu bapa dalam mengenal pasti serta menangani risiko setempat melalui pendekatan pembelajaran yang interaktif dan menyeluruh.

Bagi menandakan pencapaian penting ini, BSMM akan menganjurkan webinar, pameran dan hackathon untuk memaparkan impak program serta strategi meningkatkan keselamatan sekolah. Inisiatif ini turut akan diiktiraf di peringkat antarabangsa dengan penglibatan dan pertukaran ilmu bersama Persatuan Kebangsaan Palang Merah dan Bulan Sabit Merah dari negara-negara lain.



“BSMM komited memastikan keselamatan sekolah bukan sekadar aktiviti kurikulum tetapi menjadi sebahagian teras dalam sistem pendidikan negara. Program 5SK ini direalisasikan hasil sokongan ikhlas daripada Prudence Foundation, cabang pelaburan komuniti Prudential plc, yang mempunyai rekod cemerlang dalam mempromosikan pendidikan keselamatan untuk kanak-kanak. Yayasan Prudence sebelum ini telah bekerjasama dengan Cartoon Network untuk membangunkan bahan video dan pembacaan yang menarik bagi memastikan ilmu keselamatan disampaikan secara mudah dan menarik kepada golongan muda.

“Membina daya tahan komuniti adalah teras kepada program kami di Prudence Foundation. Bersama BSMM, projek 5SK bertujuan memperkasa pendidikan kemanusiaan yang telah diamalkan secara meluas di sekolah rendah dan menengah di Malaysia. Kami berbesar hati melihat komitmen dalam mengemaskini kurikulum bagi menangani cabaran masa kini, khususnya dalam aspek iklim dan kesihatan, untuk pelajar berumur 10 hingga 15 tahun. Projek ini memastikan golongan muda dilindungi dalam menghadapi risiko yang semakin kompleks.”

Inisiatif **5SK** merupakan langkah besar ke hadapan dalam usaha mengarusperdanakan pendidikan keselamatan dan pengurangan risiko bencana di Malaysia, sejajar dengan usaha global untuk mewujudkan persekitaran pembelajaran yang lebih **selamat dan berdaya tahan** bagi kanak-kanak.
